

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VOLCANO
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT CONCERNING WATER RATES AND
RATIONING**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District
("District") as follows:

SECTION ONE: AMENDMENT TO WATER RATES.

The charges for water service furnished to customers within the District shall be in the amount(s) set forth in the attached "Water Rate Structure" schedules, which are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION TWO: AMENDMENT TO RESIDENTIAL RATIONING ALLOTMENTS.

During the present water crisis, each residence shall not take delivery of more than 600 gallons of water per day as measured at the meter serving the residence, unless determined otherwise by the Board of Directors through the adoption of a motion at a meeting of the Board.

SECTION THREE: INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS.

To the extent that the terms and provisions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and conditions of any prior District ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation governing the same subject, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the subject matter thereof, and such inconsistent and conflicting provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules or regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held

invalid, no other provision of this Ordinance shall be affected thereby.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE.

Because of the continuing water supply crisis due to the failing nature of the District's water supply wells and the resulting need to conserve water, and in order to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the District, the water service charges set forth in Section One and the water rationing requirements set forth in Section Two shall be effective as of July 1, 2000, as determined by the District Board of Directors at its July 17, 2000 meeting.

SECTION SIX: POSTING.

The District Secretary is directed to post a copy of this Ordinance in three (3) public places in the District within ten (10) days after its adoption.
