

VOLCANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

Resolution No. 84-1

WHEREAS the Volcano Community Services District was formed to provide domestic water to the residents of the community, to provide fire protection, street lighting, and public recreation for the community of Volcano; and,

WHEREAS the Volcano water distribution system suffers from marginal engineering, antiquated construction, inadequate storage, and other deficiencies which create a potential threat to public health; and,

WHEREAS the Volcano water system has insufficient supply and storage to support an adequate fire flow requirement which creates a potential threat to public safety; and,

WHEREAS there are various grants and public agencies which can assist the District in correcting these deficiencies;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Volcano Community Services District supports an application to the Rural Community Facilities Technical Assistance Program for funds and technical assistance to facilitate the District's resolution of the problems and correction of the deficiencies.
