ORDINANCE NO. 2010-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VOLCANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REGARDING IMPLENTATION OF A CROSS-CONNECTION AND BACKFLOW PREVENTION CONTROL PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District as follows:

SECTION ONE. PURPOSE.

This Ordinance establishes policies and procedures regarding the protection of the potable water supply served by the Volcano Community Services District (VCSD) by implementing a Cross-Connection and Backflow Prevention Control Program. Program adopted June 21, 2010.

SECTION TWO. AUTHORITY.

The VCSD is required under Title 17, section 7584 of the State of California to protect the public water supply from contamination by implementation of a Cross-Connection and Backflow Prevention Control Program.

SECTION THREE. FINDINGS.

The Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District ("District") hereby finds and determines as follows: There are properties within the service area that have a Cross Connection situation and is determined by the District to require a backflow device.

SECTION FOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

The Federal Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974, and the statutes of the State of California Title 17 section 7584 state the water purveyor has the primary responsibility for preventing water from unapproved sources, or any other substances, from entering the public potable water system.

SECTION EIGHT. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days from its adoption.

SECTION NINE. PUBLICATION.

The District Secretary is directed to publish a summary of this Ordinance within 15 days after its adoption.
